CHRIST BE, OUR LIGHT, ELW~715~, IS MAY'S HYMN OF THE MONTH. In 1980, Bernadette Farrell structured this hymn that the stanzas are for signs longing for the kingdom of God. The refrain that follows is a petition that Christ would be our light and shine in our hearts as the church is gathered by the light. Bernadette Farrell is one of the most beloved composers of music for worship on both sides of the Atlantic, arriving on the liturgical music scene in the 1970s. Bernadette has a gift for composing richly meaningful, often challenging lyrics and comforting, prayerful melodies. Bernadette has always had a passion for social justice and that comes to the fore in many of her songs. Born in West Yorkshire in the north of England, she has lived in London for many years with her husband, liturgical composer Owen Alstott. Currently she is a community organizer for UK Citizens, which advocates for fair housing, a living wage, proper community policing and health care access.
