THE RLC NOMINATING COMMITTEE WANTS YOU!

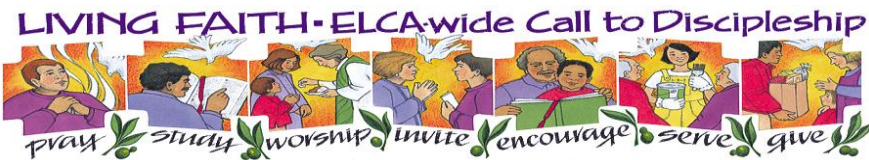
Voting three members to Church Council (two year term). Nominating Committee (one year term) at the annual meeting on Sunday, January 27, 2019. . The positions available and their responsibilities are: Vice President, Education, Resource and Management. Think and pray about which of these positions you are called to and let the nominating committee know your interest.

The Vice President shall assume the duties of the president in the event of his/her absence or inability to serve. The vice president shall serve as an advisory member of the council committees, and shall serve as the council liaison and reporting officer for all ad hoc committees, such as the Fellowship Committee, and for congregation life organizations and auxiliaries, such as Redeemer Women of the ELCA.

The Committee on Resource and Management shall concern itself with supervising the financial records of this congregation and shall provide adequate facilities, funding and management for the sound function of all other congregational activities, and shall properly maintain and repair the property of this church. This committee shall also recommend for appointment the treasurer and financial secretary.

The Committee on Parish Education shall oversee the educational programs of this congregation including the Lutheran Youth Organization, determine policies and select personnel for the various programs and shall furnish supplies and facilities for these programs.

We hope that each of you will prayerfully consider how you can use the talent which God has given you to serve as an active member of church council or committees.
